A. Items Opening Meeting

- 1. Call to order Mayor Eric Love called the meeting to order at 6:30 PM
- 2. Pledge Mayor Eric Love led the Pledge of Allegiance
- 3. Invocation Mayor Eric Love
- 4. Roll Call Vickie Knight called roll. Present were Mayor Eric Love, Mayor ProTem Lance Clinton, Councilmember Dan Olson, Councilmember Stephen Perschler, Councilmember Shelly Molina, Councilmember Don Conver. A guorum was present.

C. Mayor's Report

Monday, July 20, first day to file application for open council seats. Election is November 3, 2020.

D. Travis County Sheriff's Report

Detective Greg Pasak reported that Sheriff patrol has been concentrating hours on the weekends, there have been no major problems or issues, received several noise complaints.

Approval of minutes for June 17, 2020, Council Regular Meeting and Public Hearing.
 Mayor ProTem Lance Clinton made a motion to approve minutes for June 17, 2020,
 Council Regular Meeting as presented. Councilmember Stephen Perschler seconded
 the motion. All approved. Motion carried.

June 17, 2020 1

- Review of erroneous information updates to Comprehensive Plan Ordinance 2020-06-17 and future use map.
 Mayor Love read list for Comprehensive Plan updates. Majority of the information updated was discussed during public hearing, attorney was present, all items under attorney review as erroneous info, clerical mishap.
- 3. Review of erroneous information updates to Zoning Ordinance 2020-06-18 and zoning map. Mayor Love read list for Zoning Ordinance updates. Majority of the information updated was discussed during public hearing, attorney was present, all items under attorney review as erroneous info, clerical mishap.
- 4. Discussion of budget amendment ordinance returned for council reconsideration. Possible approval of update to budget amendment. Budget amendment presented June 17 was returned for revisit by council. This budget amendment is to adjust for revenue loss and expenses relieved due to change in billing format with Waste Connections. Councilmember Stephen Perschler made a motion to approve budget amendment as presented. Councilmember Dan Olson seconded the motion. All approved. Motion carried. (Ordinance 2020-07-15 and exhibit A-1 are attached to these official minutes.)
- 5. Discussion and possible action to establish Planning and Zoning Commission, possible appointment of Planning and Zoning advisory board members. Councilmember Shelly Molina asked that public interest in serving on Planning and Zoning Commission be requested by interest reply and short bio to Village Secretary. A special called council meeting was scheduled for Thursday, July 23, at 6:30PM for Council to review all replies of interest/bios and appoint Planning and Zoning Commission.
- 6. Discussion of proposals received from Guard Texas and Travis County ESD District 1 for security and police services within the Village of Point Venture. Guard Texas proposal for one uniformed standing officer on site forty hours per week approximately \$82,000 annually. Travis County ESD 1 proposal for one certified and sworn peace officer on site forty hours per week approximately \$98,000 annually. Mayor ProTem Lance Clinton request council also contact Travis County Sheriff Office regarding providing additional hours and establishing days of the week coverage. Councilmember Perschler inquired if Travis County ESD 1 proposal could provide options to full 40 hour week, do we have an option of number hours per week and establishing days of week for coverage? Councilmember Dan Olson shared that Travis County ESD 1 has 6 or 7 peace officers available to cover shifts for Point Venture. Travis County ESD has the ability to enforce traffic violations, disturbance calls and also enforce Village ordinance violation. Contract hours for Travis County Sheriff Office does not appear to provide the Village with specific days and times of contact hours being provided. The Village will need to know and approve contact time as Village coverage. Mayor Love and Councilmember Don Conyer will meet with Travis County Sheriff Office and Travis County ESD representative to consider either increase scheduled hours of Village coverage with Travis County Sheriff or decrease hours in proposal for scheduled hours of Village coverage with Travis County ESD.
- 7. Discussion and possible adoption of resolution updating Resolution 2010-06-03 providing consideration for adoption, amendment or repeal of ordinances of the Village of Point Venture. Update to resolution considering Council procedure as regards adoption of ordinances. Update to procedures are suggestions for Council and not required for such ordinances to be considered a valid ordinance of the Village. Councilmember Dan Olson expressed he prefers two separate readings before adoption of an ordinance. Mayor ProTem Lance Clinton also expressed preference for two separate readings. Councilmember Stephen Perschler made a motion to adopt resolution to replace Ordinance 2010-06-03 as suggested consideration for Council approval of an ordinance. Councilmember Shelly Molina seconded the motion. Mayor ProTem Lance Clinton opposed. Ayes carried. Resolution adopted.

- 8. Discussion of update to Resolution 2017-07-01 providing consideration of updating building and construction permit fee schedule. Council discussed fee and fine schedule for building and construction permit related activities. Plan review update pricing to per hour; increase to residential general cash bond, performance bond and commercial general cash bond were discussed. Building and Construction Permit Fee Schedule will be updated and presented for Council review at July 23 special called
- 9. Discussion and take possible action regarding lowering speed limit to 25 mph in Village bounds. Travis County has not been able to provide data from speed sign on loan to Village of Point Venture. Councilmember Stephen Perschler felt the Village must have enforcement to enforce a lower speed limit be able to back up lowering of the speed limit. Councilmember Don Conyer felt speed humps could be installed on Venture Drive and Venture Blvd S. Councilmember Dan Olson made a motion to approve lowering speed limit to 25 MPG in Village bounds. Councilmember Shelly Molina seconded the motion. Opposed: Councilmember Stephen Perschler, Mayor ProTem Lance Clinton and Councilmember Don Conyer. Motion is opposed.

Upon the death, resignation, refusal or inability of any member of the Committee to serve, the remaining members of the Committee shall fill the vacancy by appointment, pending an election as hereinabove provided for.

Effection of Inaction

3. Approval or disapproval as to architectural control matters as set forth in the preceding provisions shall be in writing. In the event that the authority exercising the prerogative of approval or disapproval (whether the Developer or the Committee) fails to approve or disapprove in writing any plans and specifications and plat submitted to it in thirty (30) days following such submission, such plans and specifications and plat shall be deemed approved and the construction of any such building and other improvements may be commenced and proceeded with in compliance with all such plans and specifications and plat and all of the other terms and provisions hereof.

Effect of Approval

4. The granting of the aforesaid approval shall constitute only an expression of opinion, whether by the Developer or the Committee, that the terms and provisions hereof shall be complied with if the building and/or other improvements are erected in accordance with said plans and specifications and plat; and such approval shall not constitute any nature of waiver of estoppel either as to the persons expressing such approvals or any other person in the event that such building and/or improvements are not constructed in accordance with such plans and specifications and plat. Further, no person exercising any prerogative of approval or disapproval shall incur any liability by reason of the good faith exercised thereof.
