Discuss and consider variance request for height restriction to commercial build at 300 Venture Blvd N.

Variance to height restriction request was submitted by Ameritex Builders for commercial retail building project at 300 Venture Blvd N. This request would change roof elevation by 2' at the corners and center of retail building. Councilmember Cliff McInnis requested a visual at the site be provided prior to Council approval of this variance request. Council discussed the variance request appears more of an aesthetic visual adjustment. Council discussed desire to not hold up building process.

Councilmember Justin Hamilton made a motion to approve variance request for height restriction for commercial build at 300 Venture Blvd N as presented. This variance not to exceed request of 2' at corners and center of commercial retail build. Councilmember Steve Hafner seconded the motion. Council discussed planning towards FY2023 CapMetro allotment. Discussion of raising the short-term rental annual registration fee and cost of additional security (Travis County Sheriff presence) validate increase to this annual registration fee. Staff requested to provide data regarding costs associated with short term rental registration (including personnel costs) for Council review at future Village Council meeting.



ORDINANCE NO. 2022-09-21

AN ORDINANCE OF THE VILLAGE OF POINT VENTURE, TEXAS, AMENDING APPENDIX A OF THE CODE OF ORDINANCES OF THE VILLAGE OF POINT VENTURE, TEXAS; AMENDING THE VILLAGE OF POINT VENTURE FEE SCHEDULE; PROVIDING FINDINGS OF FACT; PROVIDING FOR CODIFICATION; PROVIDING FOR REPEAL; PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY; AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, the Village Council of the Village of Point Venture ("Village Council") seeks to provide for the public health, safety and welfare of its citizens; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to Section 51.001 of the Texas Local Government Code, the Village of Point Venture may adopt and amend ordinances for the good government, peace and order of the Village, as necessary or proper for carrying out a power granted by law to the Village; and

WHEREAS, the Village of Point Venture has previously adopted certain building and construction permit fees; and

WHEREAS, the Village Council of the Village of Point Venture desires to revise such fees to ensure the cost to the Village for providing the service associated with the fees bear a reasonable relationship to the established fees; and

WHEREAS, the Village Council of the Village of Point Venture finds that the fees, as amended, bear a reasonable relation to the cost involved in the review and consideration of the permitted activities; and

WHEREAS, the Village Council of the Village of Point Venture finds the fees serve the municipal purposes of orderly subdivision development and building construction; and

WHEREAS, adoption of this ordinance will promote the orderly and safe use of property within the Village; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE VILLAGE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF POINT VENTURE, TRAVIS COUNTY, TEXAS THAT:

SECTION 1. Findings of Fact. All of the above recitals and premises are hereby found to be true and correct legislative and factual findings of the Village Council of the Village of Point Venture, are made a part hereof for all purposes and are hereby approved and incorporated into the body of this Ordinance as if restated in their entirety.

SECTION 2. Amendments. Appendix A of the Code of Ordinances of the Village of Point Venture, Texas is hereby amended by deleting subsections A3.002(f), A3.002(g), A3.003(f) and A3.005(g) thereof and substituting therefor new subsections A3.002(f), A3.002(g), A3.003(f) and A3.005(g), respectively, to provide as follows:

SECTION 3. Amendments. Appendix A of the Code of Ordinances of the Village of Point Venture, Texas is hereby amended by deleting subsection A3.005(h).

SECTION 4. Amendments. Appendix A of the Code of Ordinances of the Village of Point Venture, Texas is hereby amended by renumbering subsections A3.005(i), A3.005(j), A3.005(k) and A3.005(l), as new subsections A3.005(h), A3.005(i), A3.005(j) and A3.005(k), respectively.

SECTION 5. Repeal. This Ordinance shall be and is hereby cumulative of all other ordinances of the Village of Point Venture, Texas, and this Ordinance shall not operate to repeal or affect any of such other ordinances except insofar as the provisions thereof might be inconsistent or in conflict with the provisions of this Ordinance, in which event such conflicting provisions, if any, in such other ordinances are hereby repealed.

SECTION 6. Severability. Should any section, subsection, sentence, clause or phrase of this Ordinance be declared unconstitutional or invalid by a court of competent jurisdiction, it is expressly provided that any and all remaining portions of this Ordinance shall remain in full force and effect. The Village Council of the Village of Point Venture hereby declares that it would have passed this Ordinance, and each section, subsection, clause or phrase thereof irrespective of the fact that any one or more sections, subsections, sentences, clauses and phrases be declared unconstitutional or invalid.

SECTION 7. Codification. The Village Secretary is further directed to have this Ordinance codified at the next available codification update.

SECTION 8. Effective Date. That this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its date of passage, in accordance with law, and it is so ordained.

Travis County Sheriff Report for August:

58.5 hours deputy presence 7 traffic stops 6 traffic tickets issued

Finance Report

September 30 end of fiscal year, if available staff may request \$7,500 expenditure from net surplus for purchase and installation of US and Texas flag (Austin Flag and Flagpole-quote attached) at front door of Village office; purchase of used backhoe not to exceed \$49,000 at the October meeting.

Building Report

Village engineer, Tim Haynie, performed a site visit at commercial site at 300 Venture Blvd N. This site visit report is attached.

Village Services

Will Boettner with Travis County is prepared to meet with Village staff and council representative to brief on ideas for accomplishing our Village code lot maintenance 7.05.006 to reduce risk of fire hazard. Meeting has not yet been set.

Trash containers presence on ribbon curbs and streets is resident request to place restrictions on length of time containers may be left on ribbon curb or street. This would also include making a determination regarding the residents that must place trash/recycle out for pickup Saturday, or earlier, for Monday pick up and not just returning trash/recycle containers after Monday pick up. Village staff performed a six week study – 130 total count for containers left out beyond 48 hours of Monday pick up (approximately 20 per week). Of the 130 count, 67% were resident containers and 33% STR registered property containers.

STR update: as of 9/18/22 Granicus has identified 121 possible short term rental properties within the Village of Point Venture. Four (4) properties identified within the last 30 days. 109 properties have registered with the Village of Point Venture as a short term rental property. Granicus complaint hotline has received 9 calls within the last 30 days – 3 parking in the street complaints, 2 excessive noise complaints, 2 other (litter, encroaching on private property) and 2 calls were received just as information call (resident wanted to know how this process works??). Costs associated with short term rental registration and compliance: \$17,000 annual fee for Granicus/Host Compliance full service, 8 hours per month staff time at approximately \$3000 annual cost, admin supplies is very minimal as Granicus/Host Compliance logs, files and stores all registration, complaint through our online interface. Annual registration fee is \$300.







RE: Site Visit Notes from Walk-Thru of Commercial Property Located at 300 Venture Blvd

Date of Site Visit: 09-SEP-2022

Attendees: Tommy Low - Village of Point Venture, Jimmy Taylor - Developer/Owner, and Tim Haynie - Village Engineer

Weather: Scattered clouds, light breeze, approximately 85 degrees

Site was walked by, Tommy Low, Jimmy Taylor, and Tim Haynie beginning at approximately 11:15am.

Observations & Notes:

General Site Conditions:

- 1. Site was clear of loose trash and debris.
- 2. Construction materials storage was laid out and stockpiled in an orderly manner.
- 3. Silt fencing appeared to be in good condition.
- 4. Although the site was dry, minimal dust was being generation.

Completed Construction Work:

Retaining wall completed, backfilled and utilities behind wall reconnected and re-bedded. Earthen swale above and behind wall
has not been installed. Hand grading will be required around electrical power pad/transformer.

Construction Work Being Performed:

- 1. Detention and Water Quality ponds excavation, approximately 50% complete.
- 2. Building foundation plumbing being installed, approximately 50% complete.

Upcoming Site Work:

Building foundation concrete pour estimated to occur on September 16th.

Continued Detention and Water Quality excavation.

Miscellaneous Items:

- 1. Venture Blvd. inbound lane painted/stained red concrete section low spot in roadway near outside roadway edge, ribbon curb cracked in multiple locations through this roadway section and apparently ponds water. Discussed with Contractor how this ponding could be repaired or minimized. Discussed replacing ribbon curb and cutting a grove (approx. 1" wide) through sidewalk to drain water into a small gravel pit "rain garden" (approx. 4-ft dia. 3-4-ft deep) located beyond proposed sidewalk.
- 2. Contractor noted the required 8-ft wide sidewalk is very wide and asked if he could reduce it to 6-ft wide. Contractor was informed a variance would be required to reduce the sidewalk width before any change in sidewalk construction can begin.

Next Site Visits: (Please alert all parties a week or so before the below items are expected to be ready for viewing)

- 1. Near or at end of forming and reinforcement placement of detention and water quality ponds (prior to pouring concrete).
- 2. After grading of parking lot but before paving.
- 3. Final walk through for Punch List generation of site work.
